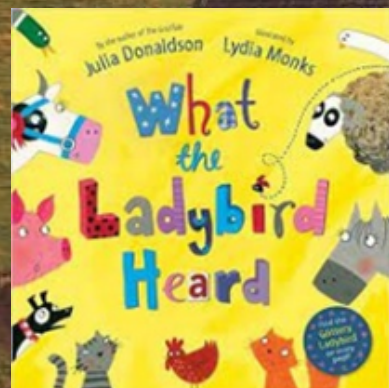


Reception Summer 1

Maths - Numbers to 20 and beyond

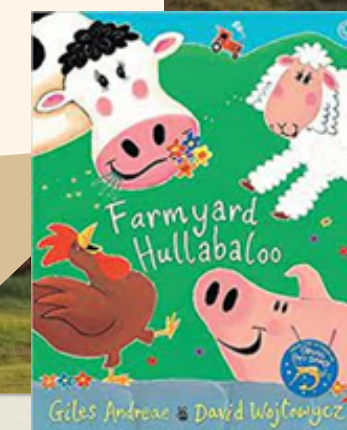


Week 3 - Can we create a farm model for Nursery?

Week 4 - How does a band work together to perform?

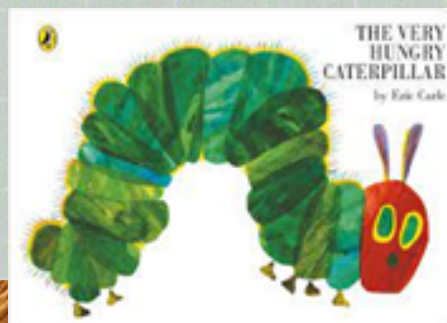
Curriculum - To know and understand that members of a band all have a role to play in producing music.

Maths - Spatial reasoning, match, rotate, manipulate.



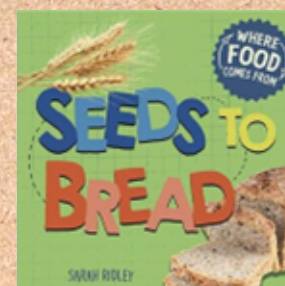
Week 5 - How is bread made?

Maths - Adding more.



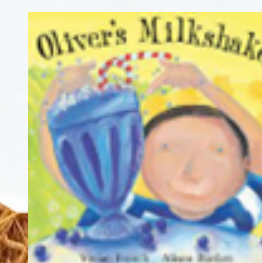
Week 6 - How does my snack milk arrive in school?
