Ideally, the successful candidate will have a level 2 Sports Coach qualification but this is not essential. A UK driving licence is also required.

### **Main responsibilities:**

- To deliver the Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 physical education programme.
- Deliver PE lessons as part of Teachers PPA from Reception – Year 6
- To be responsible for delivering and monitoring a co-ordinated programme of activities, to include games, dance, gymnastics, athletics and outdoor and adventurous activities.
- To provide high quality coaching and physical activity programmes to support the delivery of high-quality sports days and festivals of intra-school and inter school sport.
- To lead the delivery of lunchtime and after-school clubs. To ensure that positive measures are implemented to encourage the participation of disadvantaged groups of individuals.
- Support non specialist staff in delivering high quality PE lessons.
- Offer mentoring support and guidance to identified pupils.
- Cover classes as required for short term at short notice.
- Support individuals/groups with academic interventions
