Messages from Miss Stephenson

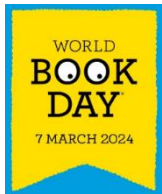

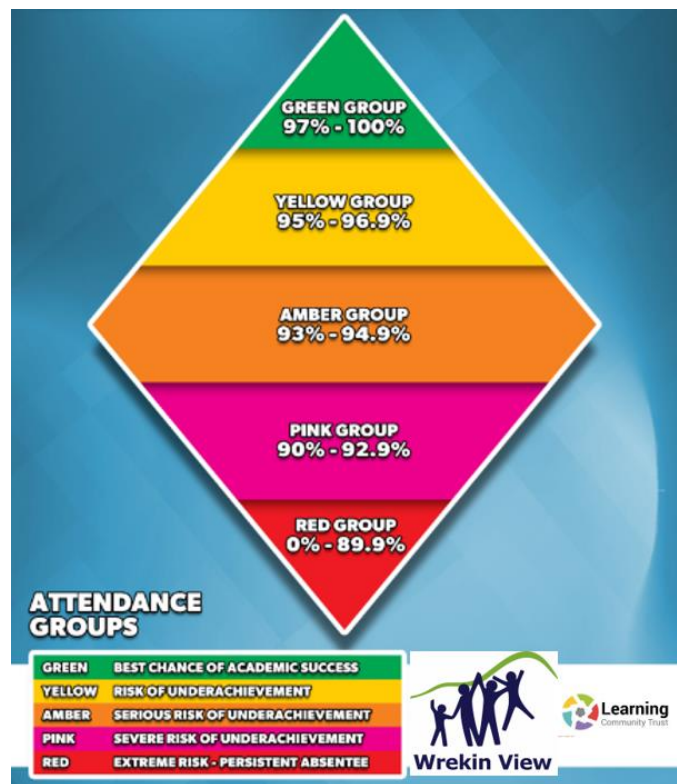
This Week's Attendance
