Mindful Parenting Course Stage 1

‘A course in self-discovery to support parenting through Mindfulness practices.’

Sessions will be on Wednesday evenings (5.00pm – 6.00pm) from 17th April – 15th May 2024 at Crudgington Primary School with Accredited Practitioner & Crudgington Teaching Assistant- Jo Flynn-Gamble.

The duration of the course is 5-weeks – to include aspects;

- Mindfulness/Meditation/Awareness.
- Bringing Mindfulness to parenting and Mindful listening.
- Building presence and connection
- Cultivating presence and reflective listening
- Activities for children to support Mindful awareness/emotional practices.

Participation in Meditation, Reflective Questions, Group Discussions and Journaling are a part of this course.
